# Certification Mark Use Policy

Once certification has been granted, a certified organisation is eligible to use ComplyNet certification mark/logo to promote its certification status.

However, the certification mark must be used within the controls and rules as defined by ComplyNet. The rules and controls issued are to ensure the certification mark is not used to inadvertently misrepresent the scope or status of certification. Should the certification mark be used incorrectly ComplyNet will issue an initial warning, subsequent misuse may result in suspension or withdrawal of certification. Should certification be suspended or withdrawn the organisation must cease use of the certification mark.

ComplyNet certification mark can be used on letterheads, advertising materials, brochures, signs, business cards, email signatures or other promotional material. The logo can only be used by the organisations/sites certified (within the scope of certification). It cannot be used by associated or subsidiary organisations unless they are also certified by ComplyNet. This includes supplier, consultant or contracted companies.

ComplyNet certification mark must not be used on a product or product packaging or in any other way that may be interpreted as denoting product conformity. The certification mark must also not be applied to laboratory tests or inspection reports.

The use of certification marks will form part of ComplyNet's surveillance and recertification audits as per the certification cycle.

The following are ComplyNet's certification marks which will be made available to certified clients for their use. Under no circumstances are the below to be reproduced in a colour combination or variance other than the below or as issued by ComplyNet. The below may be enlarged or reduced in size, however the text to remain legible. The certified organisation must only use the certification marks applicable to the scope of their certification.
